

# Little Flake the Snowman

## Materials

- Yarn: 150 yards worsted weight yarn. Sample: Red Heart Super Saver White, Pumpkin, Turqua; Caron Simply Soft Raindow Bright
- Crochet Hooks: H (5mm)
- Notions: Yarn needle for weaving in ends, 2 small black buttons, black thread, sewing needle, stuffing, black embroidery floss (mouth)
- Optional: Measuring tape, scissors, 1-2 cups popcorn or rice for a weighted stuffie + nylon sock

## Measurements

- Finished Measurements: 6" x 6"
- Gauge: not needed for this project.

## Tips

- First stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at end of row/round.

**Body**

This starts at the bottom of the stuffie and worked in continuous rounds to the top.

1. With an H hook and white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sc sts (or preferred method for creating a circle of 8 sc sts), pull closed and place a marker for working in the round. (8sts)
  2. 2sc in each st to end of round. (16sts)
  3. \*sc, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (24sts)
  4. \*sc 3, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (30sts)
  5. \*sc 4, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (36sts)
  6. \*sc 5, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (42sts)
  7. \*sc 6, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (48sts)
  - 8-15. Sc in each st to end of round.
  16. \*sc 10, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (44sts)
  17. \*sc 9, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (40sts)
  18. \*sc 8, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (36sts)
  19. \*sc 7, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (32sts)
  - 20-21. Sc in each st to end of round.
  22. \*sc 7, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (36sts)
  23. \*sc 8, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (40sts)
  24. Sc in each st to end of round.
  25. \*sc 8, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (36sts) Stop here and add the weight (optional - see note on following page). Stuff firmly to this position.
  26. \*sc 7, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (32sts)
  27. \*sc 6, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (28sts)
  26. \*sc 5, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (24sts) Stop here and add the face.
- Nose: Use a yarn needle and orange yarn to stitch a triangle for the nose.
- Eyes: Use a sewing needle and black thread to sew two eyes above the nose.
- Smile: Use a yarn needle and black embroidery floss to stitch a smile below the nose.
- Heart: Use a yarn needle and red yarn to stitch the heart to the bottom part of the body.
27. \*sc 2, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (18sts) Add more stuffing.



28. \*sc, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (12sts)

29. \*sc, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (8sts) Finish off, leaving a yarn tail for finishing off the top.

With a yarn needle, use the yarn tail to weave in and out of remaining sts. Pull to cinch closed. Secure yarn tail.

### Weighted Body (optional)

I added weight to the body before stuffing to help it stand and be roly poly.

I put unpopped popcorn (Large - 1.5 cups, Small - .5 cup) in a nylon sock. I tied a knot in the end and place it inside the body before stuffing.

Instead of popcorn, you could use dried rice, beans or bean bag pellets.



### Arms (make 2)

This starts at the “mitten” and worked in continuous rounds to the top.

1. With an H hook and yarn for the mitten, start with a magic circle of 6 sc sts (or preferred method for creating a circle of 6 sc sts), pull closed and place a marker for working in the round. (6sts)

2. 2sc in each st to end of round. (12sts)

3. \*sc 3, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (15sts)

4. Sc in each st to end of round.

5. Repeat previous round for an additional 3 rounds.

6. Sl st in next st. Work this step in FLO. \*ch 1, sl st in next st\*, repeat to end of round. Finish off yarn.

7. Attach white yarn to a remaining back loop from step 6. \*sc2tog, sc 3\*, repeat to end of round, do not join. Place marker for working in the round. (12sts)

8. Sc in each st to end of round.

9. \*sc2tog, sc 4\*, repeat once. (10sts) Insert a small amount of stuffing in the bottom/hand.

11. \*sc2tog, sc 3\*, repeat once. (8sts)

12. Sc in each st to end of round. Finish off, leaving a yarn tail for sewing to body.

With a yarn needle, use the yarn tail to sew the top edge of the arm to the body at the neck section. Sew arms at a slant so mittens hang towards the belly.

### Scarf

1. With an H hook and yarn color of choice, ch 85, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (84sts)

2-3. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.

Finish off and weave in ends.

Fringe: Cut several strands of yarn 4” long. Fold each strand in ½ and pull the center loop through a spot on one of the short ends of the scarf. Pull the ends through the loop and pull snug against the scarf. Repeat across each end of the scarf. Pull yarn tails apart.

Fold scarf in half . Wrap around the middle of the snowman and pull the scarf ends through the loop.



**Hat**

1. With an H hook and yarn for the hat, start with a magic circle of 6 sc sts (or preferred method for creating a circle of 6 sc sts), pull closed and place a marker for working in the round. (6sts)
2. 2sc in each st to end of round. (12sts)
3. \*sc, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (18sts)
4. \*sc 2, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (24sts)
5. \*sc 3, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (30sts)
6. \*sc 4, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (36sts)
7. \*sc 4, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of round. (30sts)
8. Sl st in next st. This step creates the first earflap. Ch 1, sc in the same st, sc 5. (6sts)
9. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)
10. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 3. (4sts)
11. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc2tog. (2sts)
12. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog. Finish off and weave in ends.
13. Skip 8 sts on the bottom edge of the hat. Attach yarn to the next st. Ch 1, sc in the same st, sc 5. (6sts)
14. Repeat steps 9-12, but do not finish off.
15. Ch 1, sc evenly down the side of the earflap, sc2tog in the corner where the earflap meets the hat, sl st in each st to next earflap, sc2tog where the hat meets the earflap. Sc evenly up the earflap, (sc, ch 1, sc) in the tip of the earflap. Sc evenly down the side of the earflap, sl st in each st to next earflap, sc2tog where the hat meets the earflap, sc evenly up the earflap, ch 1, sl st in first st to join. Finish off and weave in ends.

**Braids:** Cut 6 strands of yarn 8" long. Pull the ends of 3 of the strands through the tip of one earflap. Braid. Tie a knot in the end and trim yarn ends. Repeat for the second braid.

**Pompom:** Add a small pompom to the top of the hat.
