



Skater Kids Beanie

A slouchy hat with three ways to finish.



Materials

Yarn: worsted weight in choice of colors.

Sample: Black, White, Bright contrasting color (pink, green, anything fun)

Crochet Hook: I, J

Miscellaneous: yarn needle

Gauge: 4" with I Hook = 13 hdc and 9 rounds

4" with J Hook = 12 hdc and 9 rounds

Sizes: Newborn – adult

Special Stitches

Chunky HDC: YO twice, insert hook in designated st, pull up a loop, YO and pull through all loops on hook.

Tip: As you pull through the loops, pull through two, slightly rotate hook and pull through the other two loops. That will make it easier to get through the loops.

BPSC (Back Post Single Crochet): This is worked similar to a BPHDC (Back Post Half Double Crochet). Do not YO. From back of hat, insert hook to the right of the post, and down into the space on the other side of the post (yes, the post is short and spaces are small), pull up a loop, YO and pull through loops on hook.

Notes about pattern – READ FIRST

- All sizes are written separately, with 3 different ways to finish the bottom edge.
- Instructions are written for color changes as shown in main photos. Substitute colors as desired.

~~~~~ Newborn, Baby ~~~~~

Help Tip: Rounds start with 8 increases each to form a flatter top, and then switch to 6 increases each starting on round #3.

Directions:

Hook Size: Use an I hook for 0-3 mths (average); Use a J hook for 6-9 mths (average)

1. With hook and white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts), sl st to join. (8sts)
 2. Ch 1, 2sc in each stitch to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)
 3. Ch 2, *hdc, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)
 4. Ch 2, *hdc 3, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)
 5. Ch 2, *hdc 4, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)
 6. Ch 2, *hdc 5, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (42sts) 4.25" across with I hook.
 7. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc (see "special stitch" at beginning of pattern) in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 8. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 9. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, working in BLO, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 10-11. Ch 2, BPHDC around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
 12. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 13. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 14. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 15-18. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 19. Make sure crown (top) of hat is still towards you when attaching the yarn.
Change to bright colored yarn of choice and a J hook. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 20. Ch 1, TURN, BPSC (back post single crochet) around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
 21. From this point on, crochet loosely or it will affect the size of the hat.
Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk 1, sc in next st*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
 22. Ch 1, turn, sc in same first space, *ch 1, sk 1, sc in next space*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
 - 23-26. Repeat previous round.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Pompom Top: Hold one strand of bright colored yarn, and wrap 70-80 times around the palm of your hand (or a combination of colors for equivalent number of wraps). Carefully slide the yarn off your hand and wrap an 8" length of yarn around the center. Pull yarn TIGHT and knot to hold in place. Do NOT cut this piece of yarn. Cut the loops and then trim pom as desired.

Pull yarn tails from piece wrapped around the pompom through top of hat. Firmly tie a knot on inside of hat.

A piece of cardboard or pompom maker may also be used.

Leave as a slouchy beanie or add one of the following bottoms:

Earflaps and Braids Option

Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

The first row of the flaps will be worked into the BPSC round of bright color.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any st on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Ch 1, sc 10.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 6, sc2tog. (8sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4, sc2tog. (6sts)
4. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 3. (4sts)
6. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 2. (3sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc. (2sts) Finish off and weave in end.

Fold hat in half to find placement for 2nd earflap. It should start exactly across from the first flap. Starting on the RS of the hat, attach yarn and follow directions for earflap.

Braids: Cut 12 strands of yarn, 20" or desired length (sample: 2 white, 2 black, 2 bright color). Pull ends through a stitch near bottom of earflap. Pull through until even with other end and braid. Tie a knot approximately 2" from end or tie a piece of matching yarn around braid and tie a knot. Repeat for other side.

Brim Option

Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

The first row of the brim will be worked into the BPSC round of bright color.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any stitch on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Working in FLO, sc 22.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 6, sc2tog. (22sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sl st 22.
4. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Insert hook in space one row below when working sts. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 9, 2sc in next st, sc 8, sc2tog. (21sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 4, 2sc in next st, sc 7, 2sc in next st, sc 4, sc2tog. (21sts)
6. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 8, 2sc in next st, sc 8, sc2tog. (20sts) Finish off and weave in ends.
7. Attach yarn to a st on the bottom round, center back of hat. This step is worked around entire bottom edge of hat and brim. Be careful to not work sc sts on hat too snug or it will affect the size of the hat. Sts on brim ARE worked snug to help create the brim.
Ch 1, sc in each st until 1 st before start of brim, sc2tog (one st on hat and one st on brim) and pull snug. This will help the brim stand out. Sc tightly evenly across brim until 1 st remains on brim, sc2tog (one st on brim and one st on hat) and pull snug, sc to end of round, sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends. Finger shape brim.

~~~~~ Toddler 12-24 mths ~~~~~

Help Tip: Rounds start with 8 increases each to form a flatter top, and then switch to 6 increases each starting on round #3.

**Directions:**

Hook Size: Use an I hook for average size head and a J hook for more room.

1. With hook and white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts), sl st to join. (8sts)
  2. Ch 1, 2sc in each stitch to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)
  3. Ch 2, \*hdc, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)
  4. Ch 2, \*hdc 3, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)
  5. Ch 2, \*hdc 4, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)
  6. Ch 2, \*hdc 5, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (42sts)
  7. Ch 2, \*hdc 6, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round. (48sts) 5" across with I hook.
  8. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc (see "special stitch" at beginning of pattern) in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  9. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  10. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, working in BLO, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  - 11-12. Ch 2, BPHDC around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
  13. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  14. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  15. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  - 16-20. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  21. Make sure crown (top) of hat is still towards you when attaching the yarn.  
Change to bright colored yarn of choice and a J hook. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  22. Ch 1, TURN, BPSC (back post single crochet) around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
  23. From this point on, crochet loosely or it will affect the size of the hat.  
Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*ch 1, sk 1, sc in next st\*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
  24. Ch 1, turn, sc in same first space, \*ch 1, sk 1, sc in next space\*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
  - 25-28. Repeat previous round.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Pompom Top: Hold one strand of bright colored yarn, and wrap 70-80 times around the palm of your hand (or a combination of colors for equivalent number of wraps). Carefully slide the yarn off your hand and wrap an 8" length of yarn around the center. Pull yarn TIGHT and knot to hold in place. Do NOT cut this piece of yarn. Cut the loops and then trim pom as desired.

Pull yarn tails from piece wrapped around the pompom through top of hat. Firmly tie a knot on inside of hat.

A piece of cardboard or pompom maker may also be used.

### Earflaps and Braids Option

Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

The first row of the flaps will be worked into the BPSC round of bright color.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any st on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Ch 1, sc 11.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 7, sc2tog. (9sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 5, sc2tog. (7sts)
4. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 5. (6sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)
6. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 3. (4sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 2. (3sts)
8. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc. (2sts) Finish off and weave in end.

Fold hat in half to find placement for 2<sup>nd</sup> earflap. It should start exactly across from the first flap. Starting on the RS of the hat, attach yarn and follow directions for earflap.

Braids: Cut 12 strands of yarn, 22" or desired length (sample: 2 white, 2 black, 2 bright color). Pull ends through a stitch near bottom of earflap. Pull through until even with other end and braid. Tie a knot approximately 2" from end or tie a piece of matching yarn around braid and tie a knot. Repeat for other side.

### Brim Option

Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

The first row of the brim will be worked into the BPSC round of bright color.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any stitch on on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Working in FLO, sc 22.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 6, sc2tog. (22sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sl st 22.
4. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Insert hook in space one row below when working sts. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 9, 2sc in next st, sc 8, sc2tog. (21sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sl st 21.
6. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 4, 2sc in next st, sc 7, 2sc in next st, sc 4, sc2tog. (21sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 8, 2sc in next st, sc 8, sc2tog. (20sts) Finish off and weave in ends.
8. Attach yarn to a st on the bottom round, center back of hat. This step is worked around entire bottom edge of hat and brim. Be careful to not work sc sts on hat too snug or it will affect the size of the hat. Sts on brim ARE worked snug to help create the brim.  
Ch 1, sc in each st until 1 st before start of brim, sc2tog (one st on hat and one st on brim) and pull snug. This will help the brim stand out. Sc tightly evenly across brim until 1 st remains on brim, sc2tog (one st on brim and one st on hat) and pull snug, sc to end of round, sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends. Finger shape brim.

Help Tip: Rounds start with 8 increases each to form a flatter top, and then switch to 6 increases each starting on round #3.

Directions:

Hook Size: Use an I hook for size 2-5; Use a J hook for size 6-10

1. With hook and white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts), sl st to join. (8sts)
 2. Ch 1, 2sc in each stitch to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)
 3. Ch 2, *hdc, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)
 4. Ch 2, *hdc 3, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)
 5. Ch 2, *hdc 4, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)
 6. Ch 2, *hdc 5, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (42sts)
 7. Ch 2, *hdc 6, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (48sts)
 8. Ch 2, *hdc 7, 2 hdc in next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (54sts) 5.75" across with I hook.
 9. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc (see "special stitch" at beginning of pattern) in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 10. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 11. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, working in BLO, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 12-13. Ch 2, BPHDC around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
 14. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 15. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 16. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 17-22. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 23. Make sure crown (top) of hat is still towards you when attaching the yarn.
Change to bright colored yarn of choice and a J hook. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 24. Ch 1, TURN, BPSC (back post single crochet) around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
 25. From this point on, crochet loosely or it will affect the size of the hat.
Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk 1, sc in next st*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
 26. Ch 1, turn, sc in same first space, *ch 1, sk 1, sc in next space*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
 - 27-32. Repeat previous round.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Pompom Top: Hold one strand of bright colored yarn, and wrap 70-80 times around the palm of your hand (or a combination of colors for equivalent number of wraps). 5. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 5. (6sts)
6. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 3. (4sts)
8. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 2. (3sts)
9. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc. (2sts) Finish off and weave in end.

Fold hat in half to find placement for 2nd earflap. It should start exactly across from the first flap. Starting on the RS of the hat, attach yarn and follow directions for earflap.

Braids: Cut 12 strands of yarn, 26" or desired length (sample: 2 white, 2 black, 2 bright color). Pull ends through a stitch near bottom of earflap. Pull through until even with other end and braid. Brim Option

Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any stitch on on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Working in FLO, sc 24.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 6, 2sc in next st, sc 6, 2sc in next st, sc 6, sc2tog. (24sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sl st 24.
4. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Insert hook in space one row below when working sts. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 10, 2sc in next st, sc 9, sc2tog. (23sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sl st 23.
6. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 5, 2sc in next st, sc 6, sc2tog. (23sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 9, 2sc in next st, sc 9, sc2tog. (22sts)
8. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 8, 2sc in next st, sc 9, sc2tog. (21sts) Finish off and weave in ends.
9. Attach yarn to a st on the bottom round, center back of hat. This step is worked around entire bottom edge of hat and brim. Be careful to not work sc sts on hat too snug or it will affect the size of the hat. Sts on brim ARE worked snug to help create the brim.
Ch 1, sc in each st until 1 st before start of brim, sc2tog (one st on hat and one st on brim) and pull snug. This will help the brim stand out. Sc tightly evenly across brim until 1 st remains on brim, sc2tog (one st on brim and one st on hat) and pull snug, sc to end of round, sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends. Finger shape brim.

Help Tip: Rounds start with 8 increases each to form a flatter top, and then switch to 6 increases each starting on round #3.

**Directions:**

Hooks: Use an I hook for average size. Use a J hook for larger size/looser fit.

1. With hook and white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts), sl st to join. (8sts)
  2. Ch 1, 2sc in each stitch to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)
  3. Ch 2, \*hdc, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)
  4. Ch 2, \*hdc 3, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)
  5. Ch 2, \*hdc 4, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)
  6. Ch 2, \*hdc 5, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (42sts)
  7. Ch 2, \*hdc 6, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (48sts)
  8. Ch 2, \*hdc 7, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (54sts)
  9. Ch 2, hdc 3, \*hdc 5, 2 hdc in next st\*, repeat until 3 sts remain, hdc 3, sl st to join. (62sts)
  10. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc (see "special stitch" at beginning of pattern) in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  11. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  12. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, working in BLO, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  - 13-14. Ch 2, BPHDC around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
  15. Change to black yarn. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  16. Ch 2, chunky hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  17. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  - 18-24. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  25. Make sure crown (top) of hat is still towards you when attaching the yarn.  
Change to bright colored yarn of choice and a J hook. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
  26. Ch 1, TURN, BPSC (back post single crochet) around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
  27. From this point on, crochet loosely or it will affect the size of the hat.  
Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*ch 1, sk 1, sc in next st\*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
  28. Ch 1, turn, sc in same first space, \*ch 1, sk 1, sc in next space\*, repeat until 1 st remains, ch 1, sk 1, sl st to join.
  - 29-36. Repeat previous round.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Pompom Top: Hold one strand of bright colored yarn, and wrap 70-80 times around the palm of your hand (or a combination of colors for equivalent number of wraps). Carefully slide the yarn off your hand and wrap an 8" length of yarn around the center. Pull yarn TIGHT and knot to hold in place. Do NOT cut this piece of yarn. 2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 10, sc2tog. (12sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 8, sc2tog. (10sts)
4. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 8. (9sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 7. (8sts)
6. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 6. (7sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 5. (6sts)
8. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)
9. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 3. (4sts)
10. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc2. (3sts)
11. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc. (2sts) Finish off and weave in end.

Fold hat in half to find placement for 2<sup>nd</sup> earflap. It should start exactly across from the first flap. Starting on the RS of the hat, attach yarn and follow directions for earflap.

**Braids:** Cut 12 strands of yarn, 26" or desired length (sample: 2 white, 2 black, 2 bright color). Pull ends through a stitch near bottom of earflap. Pull through until even with other end and braid. Tie a knot approximately 2" from end or tie a piece of matching yarn around braid and tie a knot. Repeat for other side.

### **Brim Option**

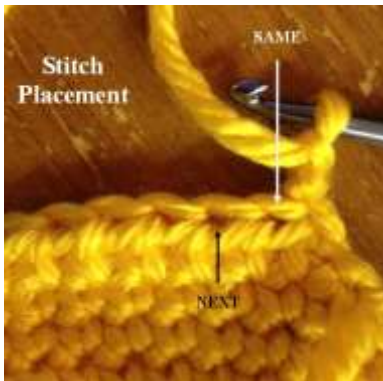
Make sure crown (top) of hat is towards you when attaching the yarn.

The first row of the brim will be worked into the BPSC round of bright color.

1. With I hook and yarn color of choice, attach yarn to any stitch on on bottom edge of hat (make sure you followed instruction above). Working in FLO, sc 26.
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 6, 2sc in next st, sc 7, 2sc in next st, sc 7, sc2tog. (26sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sl st 26.
4. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Insert hook in space one row below when working sts. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 11, 2sc in next st, sc 10, sc2tog. (25sts)
5. Ch 1, turn, sl st 25.
6. This step is worked "around" the previous row. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 6, 2sc in next st, sc 6, 2sc in next st, sc 6, sc2tog. (25sts)
7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 10, 2sc in next st, sc 10, sc2tog. (24sts)
8. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog (same and next st), sc 9, 2sc in next st, sc 10, sc2tog. (21sts) Finish off and weave in ends.
9. Attach yarn to a st on the bottom round, center back of hat. This step is worked around entire bottom edge of hat and brim. Be careful to not work sc sts on hat too snug or it will affect the size of the hat. Sts on brim ARE worked snug to help create the brim.  
Ch 1, sc in each st until 1 st before start of brim, sc2tog (one st on hat and one st on brim) and pull snug. This will help the brim stand out. Sc tightly evenly across brim until 1 st remains on brim, sc2tog (one st on brim and one st on hat) and pull snug, sc to end of round, sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends. Finger shape brim.

| Dc – double crochet | Bpdc – back post double crochet |

HEAD AND HAT SIZE CHART

new babies to adult men

I prefer to make hats approximately 1" smaller than the head circumference so they will stretch and not be too big. Note: All measurements are approximate and based on "average" head sizes according to several online sources. Hat "height" is the measurement from top of crown to bottom edge.
