



# Quick Mitts



**Materials:** Red Heart worsted weight yarn

Hooks: G

Yarn needle

Note: the body of the mitts is worked in BLO (back loop only) throughout the pattern. The thumb and embellishment are worked through both loops, as usual.

Length: Mitts should reach approximately the wrist. For longer mitts, increase the amount of initial chain stitches and then increase the first amount of hdc on the row the thumb hole is made.

**Directions for toddler size:**

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 19, hdc in second chain from hook and across.
- 2-4. Working in BLO, hdc across, ch 2, turn.
5. Hdc 9, ch 4, sk 4, hdc to end of row, ch 2, turn.
- 6-11. Working in BLO, hdc across. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing up the seam. Fold mitt in half, lengthwise, matching up the stitches. Using a yarn needle and remaining yarn tail, sew the two sides together. Turn right side out.

Thumb: Attach yarn to any stitch in the thumb opening. Ch 1, sc evenly around opening, sl st to join.

1. Ch 1, sc each stitch with 2 decreases evenly spaced.
2. Sc each stitch around.
3. Sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round. Finish off, weaving in ends.

**Directions for Child size:**

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 21, hdc in second chain from hook and across.
- 2-4. Working in BLO, hdc across, ch 2, turn.
5. Hdc 10, ch 4, sk 4, hdc to end of row, ch 2, turn.
- 6-12. Working in BLO, hdc across. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing up the seam. Fold mitt in half, lengthwise, matching up the stitches. Using a yarn needle and remaining yarn tail, sew the two sides together. Turn right side out.

Thumb: Attach yarn to any stitch in the thumb opening. Ch 1, sc evenly around opening, sl st to join.

1. Ch 1, sc each stitch with 2 decreases evenly spaced.
2. Sc each stitch around.
3. Sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round. Finish off, weaving in ends.

**Directions for Preteen/Teen:**

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 24, hdc in second chain from hook and across.
- 2-7. Working in BLO, hdc across, ch 2, turn.
8. Hdc 10, ch 5, sk 5, hdc to end of row, ch 2, turn.
- 9-14. Working in BLO, hdc across. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing up the seam. Fold mitt in half, lengthwise, matching up the stitches. Using a yarn needle and remaining yarn tail, sew the two sides together. Turn right side out.

Thumb: Attach yarn to any stitch in the thumb opening. Ch 1, sc evenly around opening, sl st to join.

1. Ch 1, sc each stitch with 2 decreases evenly spaced.
2. Sc each stitch around.
3. Sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round. Finish off, weaving in ends.

4. Sc each stitch around.

**Directions for Adult Man:**

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 27, hdc in second chain from hook and across.

2-7. Working in BLO, hdc across, ch 2, turn.

8. Hdc 11, ch 6, sk 6, hdc to end of row, ch 2, turn.

9-19. Working in BLO, hdc across. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing up the seam.

Fold mitt in half, lengthwise, matching up the stitches. Using a yarn needle and remaining yarn tail, sew the two sides together. Turn right side out.



Thumb: Attach yarn to any stitch in the thumb opening. Ch 1, sc evenly around opening, sl st to join.

1. Ch 1, sc each stitch with 2 decreases evenly spaced.

2. Sc each stitch around.

3. Sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round. Finish off, weaving in ends.

4-5. Sc each stitch around.

6. Sc each stitch around with 2 decreases evenly spaced.

**Directions for Adult Woman/Small Man:**

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 27, hdc in second chain from hook and across.

2-7. Working in BLO, hdc across, ch 2, turn.

8. Hdc 11, ch 5, sk 5, hdc to end of row, ch 2, turn.

9-15. Working in BLO, hdc across. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing up the seam.

Fold mitt in half, lengthwise, matching up the stitches. Using a yarn needle and remaining yarn tail, sew the two sides together. Turn right side out.

Thumb: Attach yarn to any stitch in the thumb opening. Ch 1, sc evenly around opening, sl st to join.

1. Ch 1, sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round.

2. Sc each stitch around.

3. Sc each stitch with 2 decreases this round. Finish off, weaving in ends.

4-5. Sc each stitch around.

### Pocket (optional)

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 14, dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and across, ch 2, turn.

2-5. Dc in same st and in each st across, ch 2, turn.

6. Dc in same st and in each st across, finish off, leaving a long tail for attaching to mitts.

Sew sides and bottom to palm or back of mitt.



### Top flap:

1. Using a G hook and yarn, ch 14, dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and across, ch 2, turn.

2. Dc in same st and in each st across, finish off, leaving a long tail for attaching to mitts.

Sew sides and top edge above pocket, slightly overlapping pocket.

### Mitten Keeper (optional):

With G hook and yarn of choice, Ch 6, join to make a circle. Sc 4 in the circle, then ch til 37" in length or longer. Sl st in 6<sup>th</sup> ch from end. Ch 1, turn, sc 4 in circle. Finish off and weave in ends.

Sew a button that will fit through the keeper opening, to the corner of each mitten.



Flower: With G hook and yarn, ch 5, join to form a circle. Note:

For interchangeable flowers, do not pull to close circle.

Sc 10 in circle, sl st to first sc (10 sts).

In first st, (ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2), sl st in next st. \*(ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2) in next st. sl st in next sc.\* continue until 5 petals are made. Finish off.



Note: For a smaller flower, omit step #1 and work petals right into beginning circle.

Bow: With G hook, ch 14, dc in third ch and across. Repeat for a total of 3 rows.

Ch 1, turn and sl st in first 5 stitches.

\*sc 2, turn\*, repeat 4 times. Finish off leaving a long tail for sewing bow to cuff.

Wrap small section around bow and use tail to sew together. Sew bow to cuff. Refer to picture for placement.



Bottom Cuff: With G hook, attach yarn to bottom opening. Ch 1 and loosely sc around opening until desired length. Note: If stitches are too tight, remove and do again or the mitts will not slide on easily.



Arm warmers created by increasing original ch stitches and adjusting hdc count on the row the thumb hole is created.



Common Crochet Abbreviations	
Ch – chain	Sc2tog – decrease, single crochet 2 sts together
St - stitch	Dc2tog – decrease, double crochet 2 sts together
Sp – space; sps - spaces	Fp – front post
Sc – single crochet	Bp – back post
Hdc – half double crochet	Fpdc – front post double crochet
Dc – double crochet	Bpdc – back post double crochet
Beg - beginning	BLO – back loop only
Sl st – slip stitch	FLO – front loop only
Yo – yarn over	** - repeat instructions between, as many times as indicated
