

Goose Necks

Materials and Details

- Yarn: a variety of colors of worsted weight
- Crochet Hooks: H (5mm), I (5.5mm)
- Supplies: Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Optional: Measuring tape, scissors
- Sizes included: 7" mini, 17" small, 23" Big, and 28" cement geese.

Tips

- The first stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain unless noted.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at end of row/round.

Mini - 2.5" x 1", 1.5" flower

Collar

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 20, sl st in the last ch from hook to join in the round. (20sts)
 - 2-4. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Rosette

With an H hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 9, 2sc in the 2nd ch from hook, 3sc in each ch to end of row. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Roll the strip, creating round layers as shown in the main photo. Use a yarn needle and the yarn tail to sew through the middle of the layers.

Use the remaining yarn to sew the rosette to the collar.

17" Small - 3.75" x 1.5", 2" flower

Collar

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 26, sl st in the last ch from hook to join in the round. (26sts)
 - 2-6. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Rosette

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 12, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of row. (11sts)
2. Ch 2, turn, 2dc in the same st, 3dc in each st to end of row. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Roll the strip, creating round layers as shown in the main photo. Use a yarn needle and the yarn tail to sew through the middle of the layers.

Use the remaining yarn to sew the rosette to the collar.

23" Big - 5" x 1.75", 3" flower

Collar

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 35, sl st in the last ch from hook to join in the round. (35sts)
 - 2-3. Ch 1, sc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 4. Ch 1, hdc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 6-7. Ch 1, sc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
- Finish off and weave in ends.

Rosette

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 25, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of row. (24sts)
2. Ch 2, turn, 2dc in the same st, 3dc in each st to end of row. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Roll the strip, creating round layers as shown in the main photo. Use a yarn needle and the yarn tail to sew through the middle of the layers.

Use the remaining yarn to sew the rosette to the collar.

28" XL - 6" x 2", 3.25" flower

Collar

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 38, sl st in the last ch from hook to join in the round. (38sts)
 - 2-4. Ch 1, hdc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 5. Ch 1, sc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
- Finish off and weave in ends.



Rosette

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 35, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end of row. (34sts)
 2. Ch 2, turn, 2dc in the same st, 3dc in each st to end of row. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
- Roll the strip, creating round layers as shown in the main photo. Use a yarn needle and the yarn tail to sew through the middle of the layers.
- Use the remaining yarn to sew the rosette to the collar.

Common Abbreviations	
beg	beginning
ch	chain
sl	slip
st	stitch
sp	space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble/triple crochet
bp	back post
fp	front post
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
sc2tog	single crochet 2 sts together
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 sts together
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
*	repeat instructions
yo	yarn over
