

Pocket Watches

Materials and Details

- Yarn: less than 30 yards worsted weight white and gold
- Crochet Hooks: H (5mm)
- Supplies: Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Optional: Measuring tape, scissors
- Sizes included: mini - 1.25" across; small - 2" across; big - 3" across

Tips

- The first stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain unless noted.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at end of row/round.

Mini - 1.25" across

1. With an H hook and worsted weight white yarn, start with a magic circle of 5 sc sts (or preferred method of starting a circle of 5 sc sts), pull to close and sl st to join. (5sts)
2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (10sts)
3. Finish off the current yarn and change to worsted weight yarn in a contrasting color (Sample: Gold). Loosely sl st in the BLO of each st to end of round, sl st to join. Ch 1, sc in the same st. This creates a nub at the top of the watch. Finish off and weave in ends.

Chain: Cut a piece of matching yarn 24" long. Pull the strands apart into 2 sections. With an H hook and one section of the yarn (2 strands instead of 4), ch 30. Finish off, leaving a long tail.

With a yarn needle, sew one end of the chain to the top nub of the watch.

Fold .75-1" at the other end and sew in place, creating a loop. Trim ends.

Face: Use the other section of yarn that was divided and a yarn needle to sew the watch hands. See main photo for placement.

Small - 2" across

This is made from 2 pieces, a front and back.

Front

1. With an H hook and worsted weight white yarn, start with a magic circle of 6 sc sts (or preferred method of starting a circle of 6 sc sts), pull to close and sl st to join. (6sts)
2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (12sts)
3. Ch 1, *sc, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (18sts)
4. Finish off the current yarn and change to worsted weight yarn in a contrasting color (Sample: Gold). Loosely sl st in the BLO of each st to end of round, sl st to join. Ch 1, sc in the same st, sc in the next st. This creates a nub at the top of the watch. Turn, ch 4, sl st in the next st to form a loop at the top of the watch. Finish off and weave in ends.

Face: Make sure the nub is at the top. With a yarn needle and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Gold), stitch the watch hands and 4 marks near the outside edge of the white section. Set aside.

Back

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Gold), start with a magic circle of 6 sc sts (or preferred method of starting a circle of 6 sc sts), pull to close and sl st to join. (6sts)
2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (12sts)
3. Ch 1, *sc, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (18sts)



4. Ch 1, *sc 5, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (21sts) Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing the layers together.

Assembly: Place the front piece on top of the right side of the back piece. The outer edge of the back piece should curl up around the front piece slightly.

With a yarn needle and a long piece of matching yarn, the two layers will be sewn together. Be aware there are more sts on the outer edge of the back piece than the front piece.

Start to the left of the top nub. Sew the layers together just inside the outer edge. I wanted the finished edges to show so I did not work around the edges.

Chain: With an H hook and matching yarn, ch 30. Finish off, leaving a long tail. Insert one edge of the chain through the top loop of the watch. Sew this end to the main chain.

Fold the opposite end 1.5" and sew in place, creating a loop. Trim ends.

Big - 3" across

This is made from 2 pieces, a front and back.

Front

1. With an H hook and worsted weight white yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sc sts (or preferred method of starting a circle of 8 sc sts), pull to close and sl st to join. (8sts)

2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)

3. Ch 1, *sc, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)

4. Ch 1, *sc 3, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)

5. Finish off the current yarn and change to worsted weight yarn in a contrasting color (Sample: Gold). Loosely sl st in the BLO of each st to end of round, sl st to join.

Ch 1, hdc in the same st, hdc 2. This creates a nub at the top of the watch.

Turn, ch 6, sl st in the next st to form a loop at the top of the watch. Finish off and weave in ends.

Face: Make sure the nub is at the top. With a yarn needle and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Gold), stitch the watch hands and 4 marks near the outside edge of the white section. Set aside.

Back

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Gold), start with a magic circle of 8 sc sts (or preferred method of starting a circle of 8 sc sts), pull to close and sl st to join. (8sts)

2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (16sts)

3. Ch 1, *sc, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24sts)

4. Ch 1, *sc 3, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (30sts)



5. Ch 1, *sc 4, 2sc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)

Assembly: Place the front piece on top of the right side of the back piece. The outer edge of the back piece should curl up around the front piece slightly.

With a yarn needle and a long piece of matching yarn, the two layers will be sewn together. Be aware there are more sts on the outer edge of the back piece than the front piece.

Start to the left of the top nub. Sew the layers together just inside the outer edge. I wanted the finished edges to show so I did not work around the edges.

Chain: With an H hook and matching yarn, ch 40. Finish off, leaving a long tail. Insert one edge of the chain through the top loop of the watch. Sew this end to the main chain.

Fold the opposite end 1.5" and sew in place, creating a loop. Trim ends.

Common Abbreviations	
beg	beginning
ch	chain
sl	slip
st	stitch
sp	space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble/triple crochet
bp	back post
fp	front post
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
sc2tog	single crochet 2 sts together
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 sts together
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
*	repeat instructions
yo	yarn over
