



# Miss Snappy



## Materials

Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in orange, pink, green, turquoise, peach, white, yellow  
Used in sample: Red Heart Pumpkin, Shocking Pink, Baby Pink, Turqua, White;  
I Love This Yarn Limelight, Light Peach, Yellow

Crochet Hooks: G, H

Miscellaneous: yarn needle, small black buttons, stuffing, black sewing thread, sewing needle, black crochet cotton or thin yarn for sewing mouth, small amount of Red Heart Boutique Sassy for skirt (optional), 6 small buttons for leg warmers (optional), 1 yard tulle (optional for tutu)

Gauge: unnecessary for this project

Measurements: 19" long (from top of bow to bottom of foot)

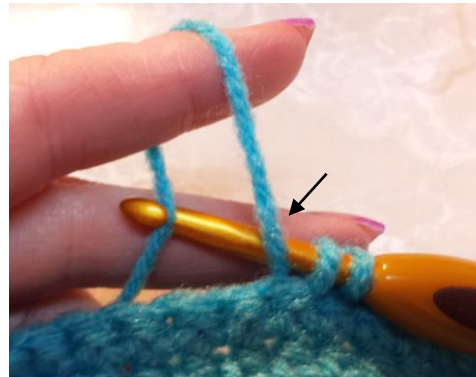

Loop stitch: I prefer this more secure method for working the loop stitch.

- Take your time. It may seem a little awkward at first, but you will find your groove.
- Rotate hook as need to help get through loops.
- For this project its ok if loops are different lengths.
- Loops end up on back of piece. For this project the loop stitch will be worked with wrong side of piece towards you.
- When working back and forth in rows, alternate loop stitch rows and sc rows to keep loops on one side of piece.



Insert hook in next st and pull up a loop.



Move working yarn in front of the hook. See arrow in photo.



Grab BOTH yarns and pull through first loop on hook. Go slow. This might seem a little tricky, especially if you crochet tight.



There should be 3 loops on the hook.



YO and pull through all loops on hook.



Loop stitch complete.

## **Doll Body**

Note: instructions start at doll's bottom with white underwear.

1. With H hook and white yarn, ch 19, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. (18sts)
  - 2-6. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
  7. Change to pink yarn. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  - 8-17. ch 1, turn, \*sc, hdc, sc\*, repeat to end of row. Note: each st in repeat is worked into a different st.
  18. Ch 1, turn, sc, sc2tog,\*sc, hdc, sc\*, repeat 3 more times, sc2tog, sc. (16sts)
  19. Ch 1, turn, sc, sc2tog, hdc, sc, \*sc, hdc, sc\*, repeat once, sc, hdc, sc2tog, sc. (14sts)
  20. Change to peach yarn (or desired face color). Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  21. Ch 1, turn, sc, sc2tog, sc 8, sc2tog, sc. (12sts)
  - 22-29. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  30. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 3, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of row. (15sts)
  31. Change to yellow yarn (or desired hair color). This starts the beginning of the hair. See loop stitch tutorial on page 2. Start with regular loops in the beginning, then do longer loops starting on row 37. For "long" hair, increase loop length each loop st row. Ch 1, turn, loop st in each st to end of row.
  32. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  33. Ch 1, turn, loop st in each st to end of row.
  - 34-47 Repeat steps 32-33. Note: all loop sts should be on the same side of piece.
  48. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 3, sc2tog\*, repeat to end of row. (12sts)
  49. Ch 1, turn, loop st in each st to end of row.
  50. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  51. Change to pink yarn. This starts the back of the dress. Ch 1, turn, sc 3, 2sc in next st, sc 4, 2sc in next st, sc 3. (14sts)
  52. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 6, 2sc in next st\*, repeat once. (16sts)
  53. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 7, 2sc in next st\*, repeat once. (18sts)
  - 54-63. Ch 1, turn, \*sc, hdc, sc\*, repeat to end of row.
  64. Change to white yarn. This starts the back of the underwear and ends with a rounded edge. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  - 65-70. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.
  71. Ch 1, turn. Working in BLO, \*sc2tog, sc 3\*, repeat until 3sts remain, sc, sc2tog. (14sts)
  72. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 10, sc2tog. (12sts)
  73. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 8, sc2tog. (10sts),
  74. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 6, sc2tog. (8sts)
  75. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4, sc2tog. (6sts)
- Finish off and weave in ends.

## **Legs (make 2)**

Note: Instructions start with bottom of shoe.

1. With G hook and orange yarn, ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc 6, 4sc in last ch. Working in back loops, sc 6, 2sc in last st, place a marker for working in the round. (19sts)
2. Sc 8, 2hdc in each of the next 3 sts, sc 8. (22sts)
3. Sc 9, 2hdc in each of the next 4 sts, sc 9. (26sts)
4. Change to pink yarn. Working in BLO for this round, sc in each st to end of round.
5. Sc 6, hdc 4, hdc2tog, hdc2tog, hdc2tog, hdc 4, sc 6. (23sts)
6. Sc 9, hdc2tog, hdc 2, hdc2tog, sc 8. (21sts)
7. Sc 8, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc 7. (18sts)

8. Sc 6, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc 6. (15sts)
  9. Sc 5, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc2tog, sc 4. (12sts)
  10. Sc in each stitch to end of round.
  11. Working in FLO, sl st in each st to end of round. Finish off. Stuff shoe firmly.
  12. Attach turquoise yarn to back loop of previous round at heel of shoe. Sc in each st to end of round.
  13. Sc in each st to end of round.
  14. Working in FLO, sc in each st to end of round. Finish off and weave in end.
  15. Attach peach yarn (same color as doll's face or see "note" below) to back loop of previous round at heel of shoe. Sc in each st to end of round.  
 Note: it would be fun to crochet this section in stripes or a color to look like she is wearing tights.
- Continue to sc in each st around until piece measures 8.5" from bottom of shoe to top of leg. Finish off and weave in ends. Repeat for second leg.

### **Arms (make 2)**

Note: Instructions start at shoulder.

1. With G hook and pink yarn, start with a magic circle of 8 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts), pull closed and place a marker for working in the round. (8sts)
  2. Sc in each st to end of round.
  3. 2sc in next st, sc 7. (9sts)
  4. 2sc in next st, sc 8. (10sts)
  - 5-7. Sc in each st to end of round.
  8. \*2sc in next st, sc 4\*, repeat once. (12sts)
  - 9-13. Sc in each st to end of round.
  14. Change to peach yarn. Working in BLO, sc in each st to end of round.
  15. \*sc2tog, sc 4\*, repeat once. (10sts)
  - 16-18. Sc in each st to end of round.
  19. \*2sc in next st, sc 4\*, repeat once. (12sts)
  20. \*2sc in next st, sc 3\*, repeat two more times. (15sts)
  21. \*2sc in next st, sc 4\*, repeat two more times. (18sts)
  22. Sc in each st to end of round.
  23. \*sc2tog, sc\*, repeat to end of round. (12sts) Lightly stuff arm.
  24. \*sc2tog, sc\*, repeat to end of round. (8sts) Finish off, leaving a tail for weaving in and out of remaining sts.
- With yarn needle and yarn tail, weave in and out of sts, then pull to close. Secure end.

Cuffs: Attach pink yarn to last round of pink. This step creates the bottom part of the sleeve.

1. With g hook, \*2sc in next st, sc 5\*, repeat once. (14sts)
  - 2-5. Sc in each st to end of round.
- Finish off and weave in ends. Roll cuff if desired.

### **Bracelets (make 1 or more)**

1. With H hook and yarn color of choice, ch 12. Sl st in last ch to create a circle.
2. \*ch 3, sl st in next st\*, repeat to end of round. Finish off. Tie a knot with beginning and ending yarn tails. Weave in tails. Slip bracelets over hand.

## **Assembly**

Lay doll body on a flat surface. The face and flower (optional) will be added before the body is sewn together.



Cheeks (make 2)

With H hook and light pink yarn, make a magic loop of 5 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 5 sc sts). Pull to close. Finish off, leaving a tail for sewing cheeks in place.

With yarn needle and yarn tail, sew cheeks to face as shown in photo above.

Face:

Note: I prefer to use crochet cotton to stitch mouth and eyebrows in place. This is different from cotton yarn. Black embroidery floss or light weight black yarn could also be used.

With sewing needle, stitch mouth in place. Sew 2 small black buttons to face for eyes. Stitch eyebrows above eyes.

## **Flower**

1. With H hook and orange yarn, make a magic loop of 5 sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 5 sc sts). Pull to close.

2. \*ch 2, 2 hdc in next st, ch 2, sl st in same st\*, repeat to end of round. Finish off, leaving a tail for sewing to body.

Place flower on center front of body. Place large button on center of flower. With yarn needle and yarn tail, sew through button, flower and body to hold flower in place. Tie a knot in back of body to secure.

## **Bows (make 2)**

1. With H hook and orange yarn, ch 21, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. (20sts)

2. Ch 2, turn, hdc 3, sc 14, hdc 3. Finish off, leaving a tail for sewing bow.

Tie a knot in the middle of the bow strip. Fold end with yarn tail towards knot. With yarn needle and yarn tail, sew end of bow strip next to knot. Fold other end of bow strip towards knot and sew end of strip next to knot. Use remaining yarn to sew knot section to top of doll's head. Repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> bow.

## Sewing doll together

### Body

1. Fold body in half, **right sides together**. Line up sections along SIDES and pin in place. Bottom edge will not line up. We will sew that closed later.
2. With yarn needle and peach yarn (face color), sew side seams together along face area.
3. With yarn needle and pink yarn (dress color), sew side seams together along dress area.
4. With yarn needle and white yarn, sew SIDE seams together from edge of dress section to beginning edge (the flat edge, not the curved one).
5. Turn doll right side out. Stuff as desired.  
Tip: for stuffing crocheted items, I like to insert a nylon sock (or foot section of pantyhose) into the doll and stuff the sock. This keeps the stuffing from working through the stitches.
6. The bottom edge will now be sewn closed. The extended, rounded edge creates a "bottom" for the doll to sit on. Ease the straight edge along the curve and pin in place. Do NOT sew yet. Place the open end of each leg between the two white layers (remove and replace pins as needed). With yarn needle and white yarn, sew the bottom edge closed.

Photo below includes skirt which has not been added yet. It is just to show the leg/body seam.



### Arms:

1. Cut a piece of pink yarn approximately 18" long. Attach one end to body, near top of dress (see arrow in photo below). Thread the other end through a yarn needle. Push yarn needle through one arm (shown in photo below). Pull yarn through so arm is next to body.



2. Insert needle in a stitch next to where it came through the arm. Push needle through body so it comes out the other side, straight across from first arm.



3. Pull needle through body. Push yarn needle through second arm (shown in photo below). Pull yarn through so arm is next to body.



4. Insert needle in a stitch next to where it came through the arm. Push needle through body so it comes out in the top part of the first arm. Pull yarn as snug as desired. The tighter you pull, the more the neck will cinch. Secure yarn by tying a knot and weave in ends.

### **Leg Warmers (make 2)**

1. With H hook and turquoise blue yarn, ch 11, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across.
- 2-11. Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st to end of row. (10sts)
12. Change to white yarn. Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st to end of row.
13. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row. Finish off and weave in ends.

Button closure:

Option 1, removable: With needle and matching thread, sew 3 buttons to starting (turquoise) edge. See photo for placement. Buttons slip through row #12 (hdc sts). Repeat for second leg warmer.

Option 2, nonremovable: Wrap leg warmer around leg so white part overlaps on outside of leg. With white yarn and yarn needle, sew along white edge, through both layers of leg warmer. Repeat for 2<sup>nd</sup> leg warmer.

## Poncho



1. With H hook and white yarn, ch 33, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 6 chs, 3sc in next ch, \*sc 7, 3sc in next ch\*, repeat once, sc 8. (38sts)
2. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 5, 2sc in next st\*, repeat til 2 sts remain, sc 2. (44sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, sc 2, \*2sc in next st, sc 6\*, repeat to end of row. (50sts)
4. Ch 2, turn, \*hdc 4, 2hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of row. (60sts)
5. Change to orange yarn. Ch 2, turn, \*hdc 9, 2hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of row. (66sts)
6. Change to white yarn. Ch 1, turn, \*sc 10, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of row, sl st in first st to join for working in the round. (72sts)
7. Change to turquoise blue yarn. Ch 2, \*hdc 11, 2hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (78sts)
8. Change to white yarn. Ch 1, \*sc 12, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (84sts)
9. Change to pink yarn. Ch 2, \*hdc 20, 2hdc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (88sts)
10. Change to white yarn. Ch 1, \*sc 21, 2sc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (92sts)
11. Change to green yarn. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
12. Change to white yarn. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. Finish off and weave in ends.

Attach white yarn to end st of beginning row (neck of poncho). Ch 1, sc in each st to end of row. Ch 19 (this creates first tie), sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch back towards poncho. Sl st in each st to end of row. Ch 19 (this creates second tie), sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch back towards poncho. Sl st in first st on neck of poncho. Finish off and weave in ends.

## **Skirt**

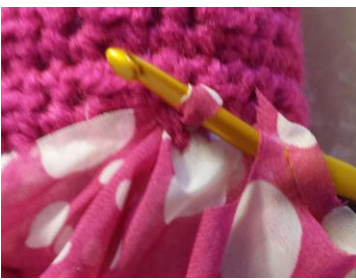
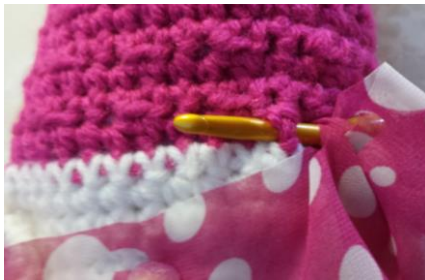
Option 1, Red Heart Sassy fabric



1. Use an H hook. The skirt is added after the body is sewn and stuffed. Notice along the top of the Red Heart Sassy fabric there are oval holes. Slip the hook from back to front into the first hole. Slip the hook from back to front into the next two holes.



Insert hook behind a post in the bottom round of pink, on the back of the doll (photo below left).  
Insert hook in next hole in fabric and pull up a loop (photo below center).  
Insert hook in next hole in fabric and pull through loop (photo below right).  
Insert hook behind next post.  
Repeat around body to end of round. Cut a 2" tail and pull through last loop.



### Option 2, Removable Skirt – Regular and tutu

1. With H hook and orange yarn, ch 33, sl st in last ch from hook to form a circle. (32sts)
2. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (32sts)
3. Ch 2, hdc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
4. Ch 2, \*fpdc, bpdcc\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join.
5. Ch 2, \*dc 3, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (40sts)  
Note: Stop here for tutu version and skip to “adding tutu”.
6. Ch 2, \*dc 4, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (48sts)
7. Ch 2, \*dc 5, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (56sts)

8-9. Ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.

Tutu Version: Cut several strands of tulle, 8” long x 1.5-2” wide. Fold in half and pull the center loop under a post in the last round of orange as shown in photo below. Pull ends through loop and pull snug. Note: The tulle doesn’t slide easily and may stretch the stitches if not careful. Place a finger on the stitch as the tulle is pulled. This will help prevent stretching.



### Option 3, Jumper



1. With H hook and turquoise blue yarn, 37, sl st in last ch from hook to form a circle.
2. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (36sts)
3. Ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.

4. Ch 2, \*dc 3, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (45sts)
5. Ch 2, \*dc 4, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (54sts)
6. Ch 2, \*dc 8, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join. (60sts)
- 7-8. Ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
9. Change to lime green yarn. Ch 1, LOOSELY sl st in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
10. Change to turquoise blue yarn. This round is worked into the blue sts from round #7 (see photo). Ch 2, \*dc, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (90sts) Finish off and weave in ends.



11. Attach turquoise blue yarn to a stitch on beginning round. This will form the "bib". Ch 2, hdc in same st and in the next 15 sts. (16sts)
12. Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc 12, hdc2tog. (14sts)
13. Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc 10, hdc2tog. (12sts)
14. Ch 2, turn, hdc2tog, hdc 8, hdc2tog. (10sts)
15. Ch 2, turn, hdc in each st across. Ch 1, sc evenly down side of bib, across back and up the other side of the bib. Ch 1, sc in same st and in each st across, sl st to join.
16. This step creates the first strap. Ch 18, hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. Sk 1 st on top edge of bib. Sl st in each st across. This step creates the second strap. Ch 18, hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. Sk 1 st on top edge of bib. Sl st in next st. Finish off and weave in ends.
17. With yarn needle and matching yarn, sew loose end of each strap to back of skirt, approximately ½ - 1" from center.
18. Optional: with sewing needle and thread, sew a small button on top of each strap as shown in photo.

Pocket (optional): Make a flower following instructions above. Sew bottom half of flower to "bib" part of jumper.

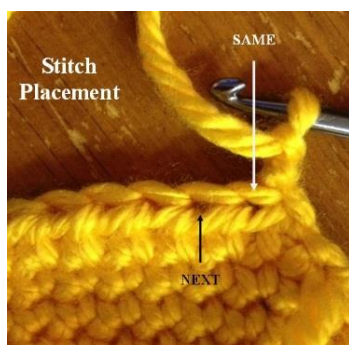
## Option 4, Attached Crocheted Skirt



1. Use H hook. With top of doll and back towards you, attach pink yarn (or color of choice) to a post on first round of dress, where it meets the white section. Ch 1, sc around each post to end of round, sl st to join.
2. Ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
3. Change to orange yarn (if desired), ch 2, \*dc 3, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join.
4. Change to pink yarn (if desired), ch 2, \*dc 3, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join.
5. Change to orange yarn (if desired), ch 2, \*dc 7, 2dc in next st\*, repeat to end of round, with dc in any remaining sts, sl st to join.
6. Change to pink yarn (if desired), ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
7. Change to orange yarn (if desired), ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
8. Change to pink yarn (if desired), ch 2, dc in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
9. Optional edging: Ch 5, sl st in between first 2 posts from previous round, ch 5, sk space, sl st in between next 2 posts\*, repeat to end of round. Finish off and weave in ends.



Common Crochet Abbreviations	
Ch – chain	Sl st – slip stitch
St - stitch	Hdc – half double crochet
Sp – space; sps - spaces	Dc – double crochet
Sc – single crochet	Trc –treble/triple crochet
** - repeat instructions between, as many times as indicated
