



Description

These little bags are designed to fit my Mini Dress Up Goose: <https://www.ravelry.com/patterns/library/mini-dress-up-goose>

Materials

- Yarn: worsted weight. Less than 25 yards per bag
- Crochet Hook: H (5mm)
- Notions: Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- Optional: Measuring tape, scissors, small button (backpack closure)

Measurements

- Backpack 2.5" x 2"; Fanny Pack - Bag 1.75" x 1"; Shopping Bag 2.5" x 2"

Tips

- The first stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain unless worked in the round.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at end of row/round.

ch	chain

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Backpack

This was designed to be worn with one of the outfits that has arms. The two straps hang on the shoulders.

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 5, 2sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc 2, 2sc in the last st. (6sts)

2-6. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st, sc 5.

7. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 2, sc2tog. (4sts)

8. Work this row in BLO. Ch 1, turn, 2sc in the same st, sc 2, 2sc in the last st. (6sts)

9-13. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st, sc 5.

14. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 4. (5sts)

15. Fold the piece in half, wrong sides together. Ch 1, working through both layers, sc down the side of the piece, 2sc in the corner, sc 2 across the bottom of the bag, 2sc in the corner, sc up the side of the piece.

16. This step starts the flap. Working in the front layer only, ch 1, sc in the same st, sc 4.

17-19. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st, sc 4.

20. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc, sc2tog. (3sts) Finish off and weave in ends.

21. From the back of the flap, sl st into the first st at the bottom right corner (of the flap. Ch 1, sc in the same st sc evenly spaced across the edge of the flap. Sl st in the first st at the opposite corner of the flap. Finish off and weave in ends.

Straps: Start with the top of the bag towards you. With an H hook and matching yarn and from the back of the bag, sl st in one top corner of the bag, ch 20, sl st in the middle of the bottom edge, ch 20, sl st in the opposite top corner. Finish off and weave in ends.

Button Closure (optional): With an H hook and matching yarn, sl st into the middle of the outer edge of the flap, ch 5, sl st in the same spot on the flap. Finish off the yarn and weave in the ends. This loop will slip over the button (for bigger buttons create a longer chain).

Fold the flap down to find placement for the button. With a sewing needle and matching thread, sew the button in place.

Slip the chain loop over the button.



Fanny Pack

This simple little bag is the perfect size for fitting the little necessities for shopping or going on walks.

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 31, sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc 5. (sts)
2. Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc 2, sc2tog. (4sts)
3. Work in BLO. Ch 1, turn, 2sc in the first st, sc 2, 2sc in the last st. (6sts)
4. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
5. Ch 1, turn, sl st into the first st/corner of both layers. Sl st down the sides, across the bottom, and up the other side. Sl st through the corner of both layers. Sl st in each ch across. Sl st into the other corner of the bag to connect this end of the strap. Finish off and weave in ends.



Shopping Bag

This starts at the bottom of the basket.

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 9, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (8sts)
 2. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st and in each st to end of row.
 3. This step is worked around the outer edge of the rectangle. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st, sc 6, 2sc in the last st, sc in the side of the rectangle, 2sc in the first st of the bottom row, sc 6, 2sc in the last st, sc 2 in the side of the rectangle, sl st in the first st to join (22sts)
 4. Ch 1, sc in BLO of each st to end of round, sl st to join.
 - 5-9. Ch 1, sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join,
 10. Sl st in each st to end of round. Finish off and weave in ends,
- Handle: Flatten the bag, centered with the bottom rectangle. Find the middle stitch of the top edge and join matching yarn to this stitch with an H hook and matching yarn. Ch 19, sl st in the middle st of the top edge directly across from the first handle st. Finish off and weave in ends.
