

## Snappy Spinner

### Materials and Details

- Yarn: approximately 170-200 yards Red Heart Super Saver
- Crochet Hook: G (4.25-4.5mm)
- Miscellaneous Supplies: Yarn needle, scissors
- Optional: Weed trimmer line

### Tips

- First stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Instructions are written with color changes as shown in sample. Substitute colors as desired.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at the end of the line.
- Reminder: sc 3 = sc one st in each of the next 3 sts; 3sc in next st = work 3sc sts in the next (one) st

Common Abbreviations	
beg	beginning
ch	chain
sl	slip
st	stitch
sp	space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble/triple crochet
bp	back post
fp	front post
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
sc2tog	single crochet 2 sts together
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 sts together
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
*	repeat instructions
yo	yarn over

## Directions

Change yarns each row or make the whole thing in one color. Choose as you go for a variety or spinners.

1. With a G hook and worsted weight yarn, ch 76, sc in 2nd ch and across. (75sts)
2. Ch 1, turn, 2hdc in each st until 1 st remains, 3hdc in the last st. (151sts)
3. Ch 1, turn, 3hdc in the same st, ch 1, sk 1, \*3hdc in the next st, ch 1, sk 1\*, repeat until 1 st, 3hdc in the last st. (303sts)
4. Ch 1, turn, sc in the same st, ch 1, sc in the next st, ch 1, sc in the empty st one row below (work the sc a little taller than usual), ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc one row below\*, repeat until 3 sts remain, sc 3.

Tip: there is a ch 1 between each st. If you will keep that in mind it makes it easier to remember the st pattern.

At the end of this step the piece should look similar to the photo at the right. You can finish it off at this point or add the weed trimmer line to help define the layers.

**Extra Row/Weed Trimmer:** If weed trimmer line will be used to help define the layers, work the sts of this row over weed trimmer line. Read the tips below before beginning. Tips for using weed trimmer line:

- Take your time. Once you get going it's MUCH easier than you think.
- Leave 6 or more inches at each end for weaving in when crocheting is complete.
- Try to work with the weed trimmer in its natural circle rather than fighting against it.

Ch 1, turn, (sc, ch 3, sc) in the same st, \*sc in the next st, (sc, ch 3, sc) in the next st\*, repeat to end of row.



Finishing the spinner: Decide which way you want your spinner to hang. From one end I think they look like umbrellas (wrong side up) and the other way looks like little saucers (right side up).

Attach a fishing spinner to the tip of the top end.
