

Blooming With Hope Cloths

A cheerful flower cloth inspired by the center of Heidi's Blooming With Hope afghan block.

Materials & details

- **Yarn:** 100–125 yards of worsted weight cotton yarn in 1–3 colors
- **Crochet hook:** I (5.5 mm)
- **Notions:** Yarn needle for weaving in ends
- **Finished measurement:** Approximately 7.5 inches across

Tips

- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.

Directions

1. With an I hook and your chosen center color, make a magic circle of 8 sc sts (or use your preferred method for starting a circle of 8 sc sts). Join and pull closed. (8 sts)
2. Special puff stitch used for rounds 2–4: Yarn over and insert hook in the same st, pull up a loop; yarn over and insert hook in the same st again, pull up a loop; yarn over and pull through all loops on hook.
Ch 1. Work 2 puff stitches in each st around; sl st in first st to join. (16 sts)
3. Ch 1, 1 puff stitch in same st, 2 puff stitches in next st; *1 puff stitch in next st, 2 puff stitches in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (24 sts)
4. Ch 1, 1 puff stitch in same st, 1 puff stitch in next st, 2 puff stitches in next st; *1 puff stitch in each of next 2 sts, 2 puff stitches in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (32 sts)



5. Change to the stripe color between the flower center and petals. Ch 1, *sc 3, 2 sc in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (40 sts)
6. Change to the petal color. Ch 1, *hdc 4, 2 hdc in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (48 sts)
7. Ch 1, sc in same st, sc 2, (sc, dc, sc) in next st; *sc 3, (sc, dc, sc) in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st to join. (72 sts)
8. Ch 1, sc in same st, sc 2, (sc, hdc) in next st, 3 dc in next st, (hdc, sc) in next st; *sc in next st, sl st in next st, sc in next st, (sc, hdc) in next st, 3 dc in next st, (hdc, sc) in next st*; repeat to end of round, sl st in first st to join. Finish off and weave in ends. (12 petals)
