

Fall Kitchen Towel

Materials and Details

- Cotton Yarn: 100 yards orange (two shades @ 50 yards each); small amounts of brown or green, goldcream
- Crochet Hook: I (5mm)
- Miscellaneous: Yarn needle for weaving in ends, 1" button to match
- Gauge: Not needed for this project
- Finished Measurements: 10" across bottom edge x 16" tall

Tips - please take a second to read this section

- The first stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain unless noted.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at end of row/round.

- Finger shape the pieces for a smooth edge (see tips on last page)
- Reminder: sc 3 = sc one st in each of the next 3 sts; 3sc in next st = work 3sc sts in the next (one) st



Directions

This project starts with the towel section, worked back and forth in rows.

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: orange), ch 40, sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (39sts)

Note: Work the following rows in BLO unless noted in the pattern.

2. Ch 1, turn, sc IN the same st, sc 14 in BLO, *hdc in BLO of next st, dc in BLO of next st*, repeat to end of row. (stitch count remains the same until noted)

3. Ch 1, turn, hdc in the BLO of the same st, dc in BLO of the next st, *hdc in BLO of next st, dc in BLO of next st*, repeat 10 more times. Sc 14 in BLO. Sc IN the last st.

Color Note: After 2 rows of the current color, finish off and change to a different color (Sample: Dark Orange). Keep changing after 2 rows of each color.

4. Repeat steps 2-3 creating 9 stripes (18 rows). Make sure to end at the narrow end/top of the towel.

5. This step is worked down the side, across the bottom, and up the other side. Ch 1, turn, starting in the next st, loosely sl st in each st to end of row, down the side of the cloth.

Sc evenly across the bottom of the cloth.

Loosely sl st in each st up the side of the cloth.

6. This step is worked down the side, across the bottom, and up the other side. Ch 1, turn, starting in the next st, loosely sl st in each st across 3 sides (the stitches worked in step 5). Finish off and weave in ends.

Stem/Hanger

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Green), ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (6sts)

2. This step creates the button hole. Ch 1, turn, sc 2, sk 2, ch 3, sc 2.

3. Ch 1, turn, sc 2, sc 3 around chain, sc 2. (7sts)

4. Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.

5. Repeat previous row 21 times (total of 22 sc rows).

6. Ch 1, turn, 2hdc in the same st, hdc in the next st, sc in each st to end of row. (8sts)

7. Repeat the previous row, increasing one st per row, until there are 15 sts.

8. Ch 2, turn, 2hdc in the same st, sc in the next st, sl st in each st until 2 sts remain, sc in the next st, (2hdc, ch 2, sl st) in the last st. Finish off, leaving a long tail for sewing stem to pumpkin.

Place the bottom edge of stem along the top of the cloth. The stem should be on top of the right side of the cloth, overlapping less than 1".

Fold the top of the stem forward to find button placement. The sample button is sewn just above the increases, where the stem starts to flair out.

With a yarn needle and matching yarn, sew the button to the stem.



Flower

1. With an H hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Gold), start with a magic circle of 5sts (or preferred method for starting a circle of 5 sc sts), pull closed and sl st to join. (5sts)
2. Ch 1, 2sc in each st to end of round, sl st to join. (10sts)
3. Ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, 2tr) in same st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, (2tr, dc, hdc, sc) in next st, *(sc, hdc, dc, 2tr) in same st, ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, (2tr, dc, hdc, sc) in next st*, repeat to end of round. Finish off, leaving a yarn tail for sewing flower in place.

With a yarn needle, use the remaining yarn tail to sew the flower to the base of the stem.



Common Abbreviations	
beg	beginning
ch	chain
sl	slip
st	stitch
sp	space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble/triple crochet
bp	back post
fp	front post
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
sc2tog	single crochet 2 sts together
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 sts together
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
*	repeat instructions
yo	yarn over
