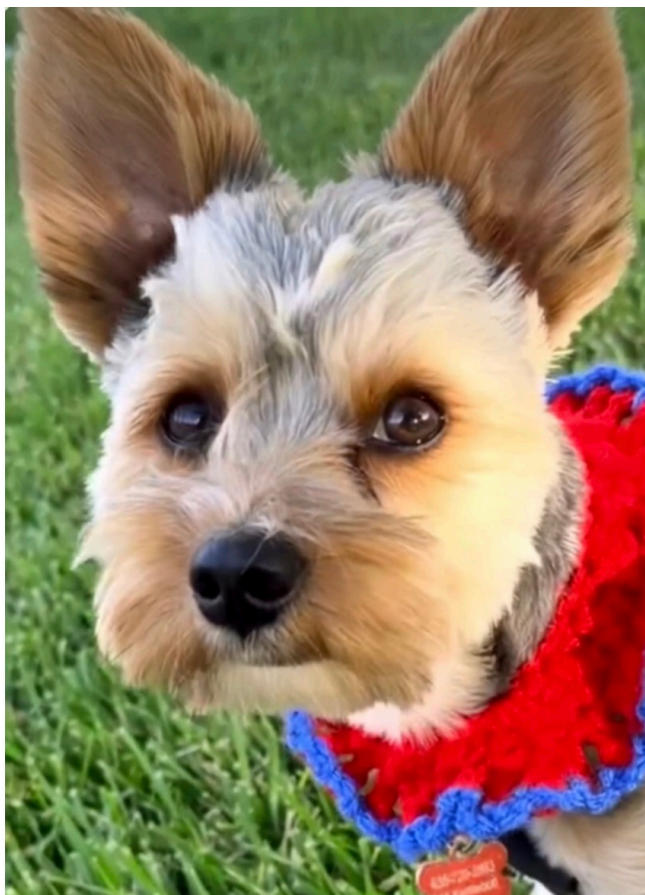


Ruffled Collar

Description: This was made for my dogs to wear for the Fourth of July. It would also be cute on a stuffed animal or even a porch goose. Please take caution when using with a live animal or person so it is loose. Never leave unattended. This is not meant to be a harness.



Materials and Details

- Yarn: less than 50 yards worsted weight in a variety of colors
Sample yarns: Red Heart Super Saver Cherry, Royal Blue
- Crochet Hook: I (5.5mm)
- Miscellaneous Supplies: Yarn needle, scissors, tape measure
- Finished Measurements: neck: 12.75" around; ruffle width: 2"

Tips

- First stitch of each row is worked into the same stitch as the turning chain.
- Numbers at the beginning of each line may refer to steps and not indicate number of rows.
- Instructions are written with color changes as shown in sample. Substitute colors as desired.
- Stitch count remains the same unless noted at the end of the line.
- Special stitch (optional): FSC, foundation single crochet - <https://youtu.be/XuFVhhE37Os?si=IHqZnI-05V-Uvc3e>

Directions

This is designed to fit a 10 lb Yorkie with a neck circumference of 9".

Custom Sizes: Adjust beginning chain amount to fit smaller or larger dogs, making sure to allow extra room around the neck. The beginning chain should be an even number.

1. With an I hook and worsted weight yarn (Sample: Cherry), ch 34, sl st in the first st to join in the round.
(34sts) Tip: a foundation chain would be a great way to start this project instead of a regular chain because it will stretch more (see special stitch at the beginning of this pattern). Choose whichever technique you prefer.
2. Ch 1, hdc in the same st and in each st to end of round, sl st to join.
3. Ch 1, *FPDC around the next post from the previous round, BPHDC around the next post from the previous round*, repeat to end of round, sl st to join.
4. Ch 3, dc in the same st, *ch 3, dc in the next st*, repeat to end of round, sl st in the first space to join. Finish off and weave in ends.
5. Change to worsted weight yarn for the trim edge (Sample: Royal Blue). Start in any ch space. Ch 3, sl st in the next ch space*, repeat to end of round. Finish off and weave in ends.

Common Abbreviations	
beg	beginning
ch	chain
sl	slip
st	stitch
sp	space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
tr	treble/triple crochet
bp	back post
fp	front post
blo	back loop only
flo	front loop only
sc2tog	single crochet 2 sts together
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 sts together
dc2tog	double crochet 2 sts together
*	repeat instructions
yo	yarn over



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
